Application Guidelines and Submission Checklist

- ☐ Applicant must personally be, or the immediate relative of, a Credit Union of the Rockies member as of January 1, 2017 and in good standing.
- ☐ Be a 2017 graduating high school senior.
- ☐ Have a cumulative high school grade point average of 3.0 or above.
- ☐ Application must be signed and complete. Incomplete applications will not be considered.
- ☐ Print in black or blue ink, or type your application.
- ☐ Include the following documentation along with your application:
 - o A 1-2 page resume; this should include your extracurricular school activities, leadership positions, awards of honors and your involvement in community activities.
 - o One reference letter on letterhead from any of the following; Teacher, Professor, Counselor, Advisor, Employer, or Community Leader
 - o Completed questions and essay material.
